- Family and Charitable Planning with Retirement Accounts w/ Christopher Hoyt

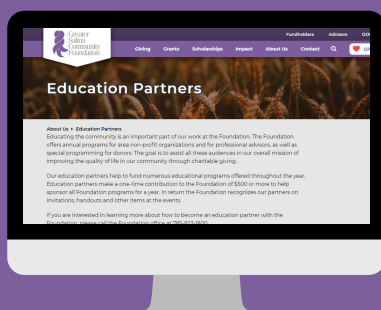


## For Donors
