## Connecting people **to their passion**

### Dr. Paul D. Ellison: A Gift Come Full Circle

As we celebrate our 25th anniversary, it's only fitting that we also celebrate the single largest gift to our Administrative Endowment Fund (the fund that started it all) from the estate of Founding Donor Dr. Paul D. Ellison.

Paul was a gifted ophthalmologist who performed countless eye surgeries during his decades-long career in Salina. He passed away in 2023 and will be remembered most for his love of medicine and helping people.

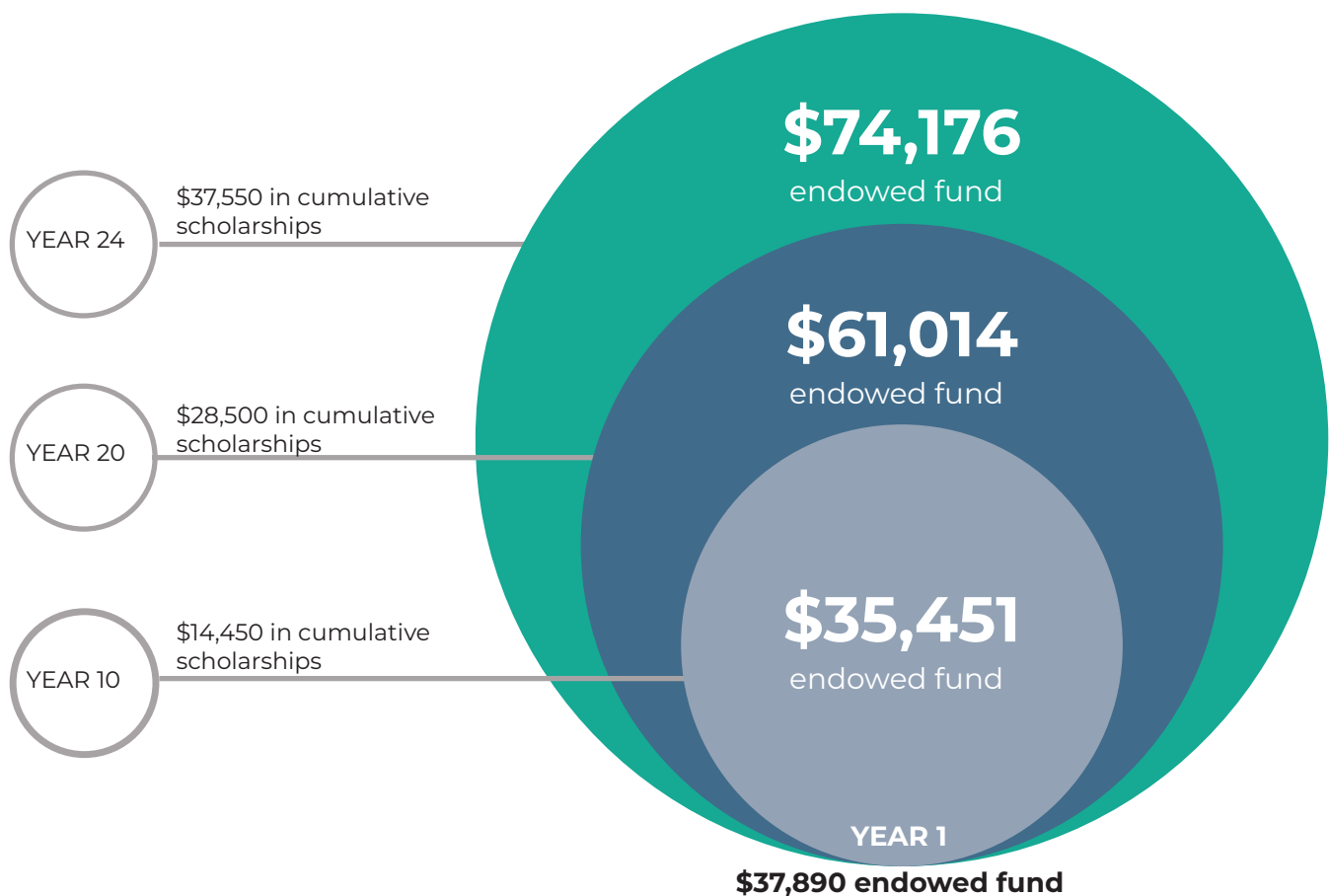
He also believed in the power of saving, compound interest and endowment building. When asked to become a Founding Donor, he "enthusiastically said yes, giving more than the \$25,000 ask."

When Paul retired, he designated the Foundation as a charitable beneficiary of his investment accounts to create a permanent endowment fund to support six of his favorite charities.

"Paul viewed GSCF as the perfect conduit and vehicle to accomplish his charitable giving goals," said attorney Pete Peterson. "Paul also understood the importance of the Foundation itself to be permanently endowed, which is why one of the six charities chosen was the Foundation's Administrative Endowment, the very fund he helped start 25 years earlier."

# Long-term Growth and Impact

Funds at the Community Foundation are invested for long-term growth with a goal to increase the fund balance and amount of grants awarded annually, while at the same time keeping the original gift in tact.



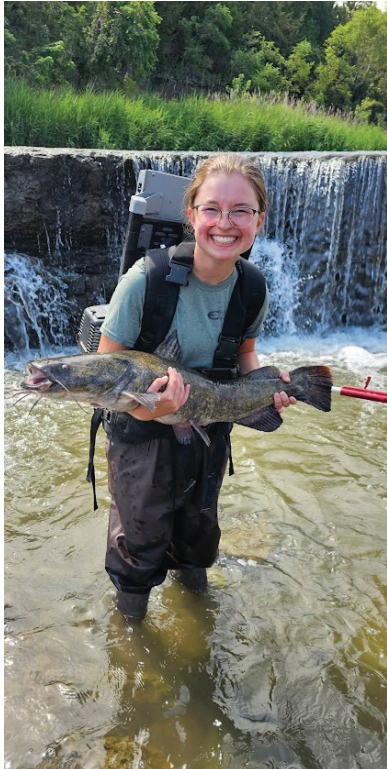
## Power of endowment

This example is based on a 5% annual payout with a 1% administrative fee and a 10-year annualized 7.8% rate of return (as of 06/30/2024).

## Fund Case Study:

The Booker T. Washington Scholarship Fund was GSCF's first scholarship fund and was established with an initial gift of \$37,890 after funds were transferred from the YWCA in February 2000. Since established this fund has awarded \$37,550 in renewable scholarships to benefit 38 African American students in Salina. See illustration above for long-term growth and impact.

The goals of the program are to connect youth and adults in our community with our waterway and its wildlife through the exciting, hands-on experience of field science. A grant from the L.P. "Pat" Mullen Fund helped purchase equipment and cover expenses for six aquatic biologists from Emporia State University to work with students.

been in a river, or even been down to see the Smoky Hill River. They were unaware of the types of animals making their homes there, or that the animals present could reveal the health of the river," said Anne Hoekstra, Education Outreach Coordinator. "This experience will have ripple effects, as each student now carries with them a better understanding of a river, the knowledge of applied science, and an appreciation of nature that will last their whole lives."

"I was surprised to learn that many of the students we worked with had never



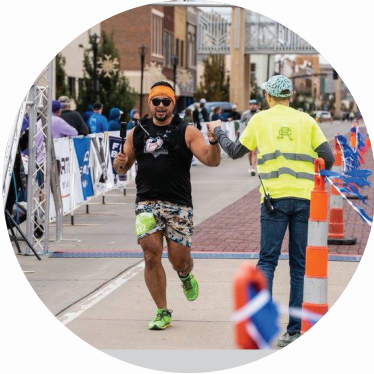

## Match Madness raises over \$1M in one day!

The 13th year of Match Madness proved to be “The Lucky One,” raising over \$1.1M in a single day for 100 local nonprofits, setting a new record!

On March 21, 2024, donors contributed \$786,246 to 100 nonprofit endowed funds held at the Foundation for long-term support. That combined with \$320,171 in matching funds and bonus prizes brought the total impact for the day to \$1,106,417.

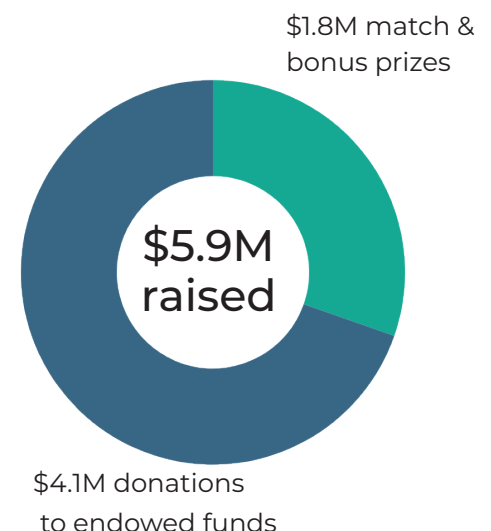

Larry and Millie Triplett were Founding Donors of Greater Salina Community Foundation and used the Foundation to assist with their charitable giving through a donor advised fund while Larry was alive. After Larry passed in 2019, the family decided to turn the donor advised fund into a permanent scholarship fund that will forever impact students, while also carrying on Larry’s legacy of hard work and grit.

The scholarship fund supports students up to age 30 in the 9-county service area of Triplett, Inc. Where there’s a 24/7 Travel store, you will likely find a student impacted by this scholarship!

Recipients must be enrolled in a full-time course of study in Kansas and possess a strong work ethic. Preference is given to those with financial need and plans to return to the Triplett, Inc. service area. This year, 21 scholarships were awarded to a mixture of students attending two-year or four-year post-secondary institutions ranging from barber school to medical school.

## 25 years of Making a Mark

### Committed from the Beginning

The Salina Family YMCA has been a part of the Greater Salina Community Foundation's story from the beginning. In 1999, they became a Founding Donor of the Foundation and established an organization fund that provides the YMCA with an annual stream of income.

"The decision to become a Founding Donor was easy," said former YMCA Foundation board member John Mize. "It has been neat to see this partnership continue to grow to impact the Salina community."

Fast forward 25 years to now, the YMCA has received over \$1.3 million in support through various donor funds held at the Foundation, helping it make a mark in our community by building community and transforming lives.

### Building Community Through Wellness

When entering the YMCA, it doesn't take long to detect the strong sense of community that has been built here. Amid the sea of workout

equipment and sport courts, relationships are formed, some lasting a lifetime.

"The most rewarding part of working at the YMCA, are all the different opportunities where people can get involved in their wellness," said Executive Director, Chris Lehecka. "From those working out in the wellness area, to the coffee drinkers who just have a membership for the social aspect, there is something for everyone."

One of the newest wellness opportunities is a mixed-used one-half mile concrete trail along the Smoky Hill River next to the YMCA, that is part of the Smoky Hill River Renewal Project.

"This is another opportunity for people to get outside and connect to nature whether it's through walking, running or biking," said Lehecka.

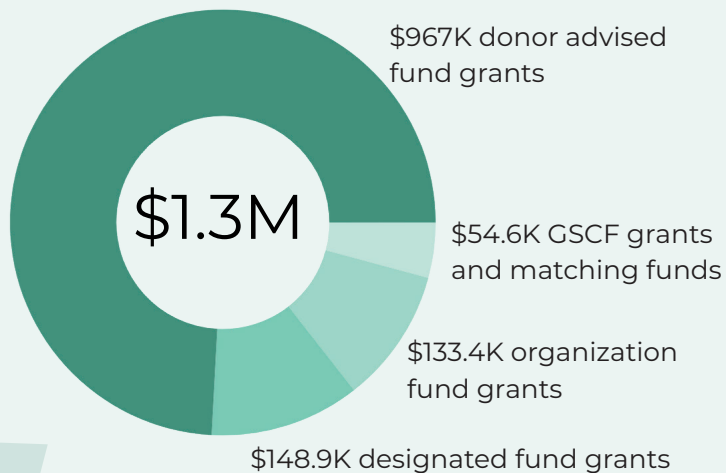

# Your Impact

Since the Foundation was established, the Salina Family YMCA has received \$1.3M in grant funds through different resources at the Foundation on behalf of donors like you. Here's the breakdown:



to the Y's mission, so when the YMCA was approached to expand its child care services, it was a no brainer.

Through a partnership with Schwan's and the Salina Area United Way's Early Child Care Initiative, the YMCA opened its doors in January 2024 to 47 children ranging from 6 weeks in age to 5 years old.

Having consistent funding from places like the Foundation has also been important in enabling the YMCA to expand its reach to more children and families.

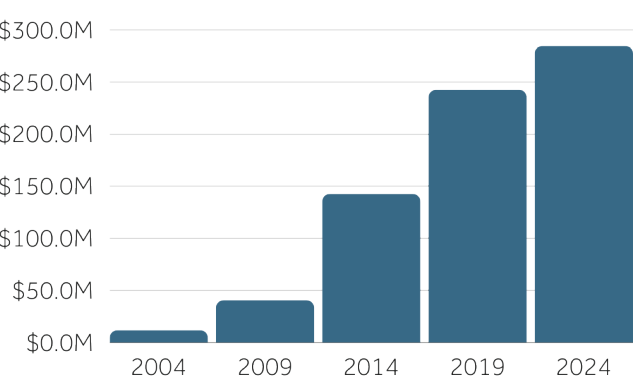

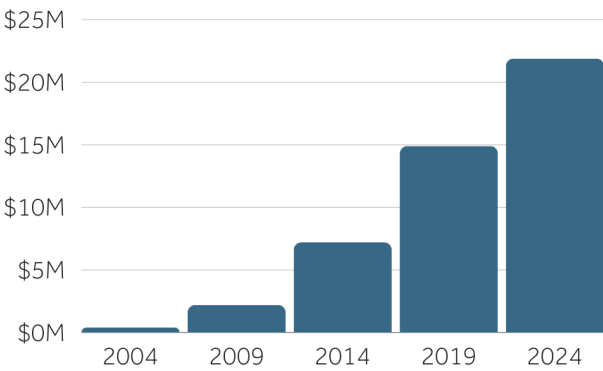

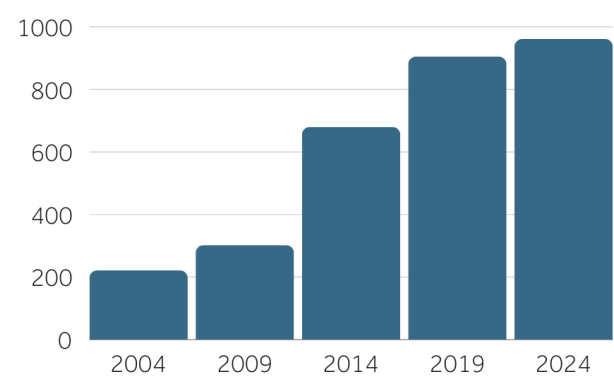

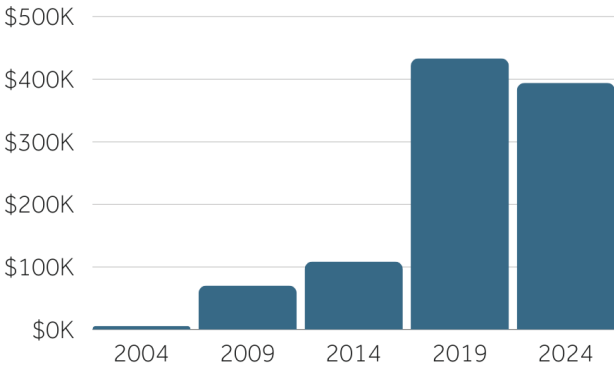
Total Assets
